The Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Kennett Square is accepting applications for the position of **Entry Level Police Officer**.

APPLICANTS' GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be 21 years of age.
- Must be a United States citizen.
- Must be a high school graduate or G.E.D. recipient.
- Must be physically and mentally fit to perform all duties and essential job functions of a police officer.
- Possess a valid PA driver's license.
- Possess a valid Selective Service Number, Active Military Identification Number, or Department of Defense 214 as required by Federal Law.
- Possess Act 120 status from a Certified Pennsylvania Police Academy before receiving a Conditional Offer of Employment.

Applicants must undergo a written examination, physical agility examination, oral examination, background investigation and must meet all requirements of the Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Kennett Square and the requirements of the PA Municipal Police Education and Training Commission. Successful applicant must undergo a polygraph examination.

Part One of the Application must be received by the Office of the Borough Secretary no later than 4:00 p.m. on February 9, 2018. A non-refundable application fee of \$35, payable by cash or check, must accompany Part One of the application. Part Two of the application must be received by the Office of the Borough Secretary no later than 4:00 p.m. on March 28, 2018.

The date, time and place of the written examination, oral examination and physical agility testing shall be scheduled by the Commission and eligible applicants will be advised.
