AGENDA ITEM TITLE: CONSIDER MUNICIPAL REFUSE AND RECYCLING CONTRACT EXTENSION

DESCRIPTION: The five-year contract with A.J. Blosenski expired at the end of 2019. Last year Borough Council authorized Option Year 1 extending the contract through the end of 2020. We have two, one year options included in the contract and this would be our final extension. Based on the increased costs of recycling across the County and Blosenski's Option Year 2 rate we recommend awarding to Blosenski in the amount of \$228,639.00 for 2021. This represents an increase of 6% from 2020.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: I move to award Option Year 2 of the refuse and recycling contract to A.J. Blosenski.


